We are seeing good volume in supply and price remains stable.

Lettuce

Romaines- Supply is steady, with hearts down in quality due to weather
Green and Red Leaf – Supplies are fairly steady

Iceberg lettuce - Market has slowly returned to normal, but supplies are still down
Butter lettuce – Supply, demand, and quality are good

Mushrooms

Mushroom growers are still recovering from the severe damage and supply will be affected for several months . We are starting to see some improvements of supply and will keep you informed of any changes.



Cantaloupe - Production is down, quality is down **Honeydew -** Production is same as Cantaloupe.

Potatoes

Idaho - supplies are tight on larger size and prices are higher than normal due to the delayed planting earlier this year caused by the weather. Washington supplies are good and prices remain stable.

> Yukon bakers - Availability is limited and pricing remaining higher than normal Russet - Quality is getting better while pricing is coming down - two months **Kennebec -** Very short right now and the quality is fair at best.

Crops in good supply and quality is good

Stone Fruit

Product still coming from Chile as we approach our local season Peaches – Murray Farms and Scott's Farms have small very early peaches in small quantity and Summer Harvest begins at Saturday Market Cherries – Murray's Farms and Scotts Farms have begun their seasons. Price is slowly coming down

Tomatoes

Round- EXTREME- supply has loosened up, but quality and color is fair Romas- Prices are down, with new crop beginning **Grapes-** Product is gapping and will improve over next two weeks **Cherry-** supply is good, quality is fair **Heirloom-** supply is good, quality is fair, lots of unripe fruit, no local product



Spring is here, peas, favas, snow peas, cherries, and mulberries are at the market Peaches have shown their face a bit, but small, watery, and sour


