Asparagus Supplies have tightened up in Peru due to cold weather. Expect sizing issues

> **Avocado** Large fruit is stable with tighter market on smaller sizing.

> > **Bananas** Steady supply with good quality

Broccoli, Cauliflower, Broccolini. Brussels Sprouts, and Green Onions

Broccoli – Supplies are steady Cauliflower-Supplies are light Broccolini – Market is steady Brussels Sprouts- supply has improved Green Onions – Market has stabilized

Berries

Strawberries – quality and supply is back and forth with labor day approaching Raspberry - supply and quality has improved Blackberries – Heat is affecting supply and quality Blueberries – Supply is improving

Bell Peppers and Peppers Green Bell Red Bell Yellow Bell Pepper Anaheim's, Habanero All peppers are still a bit light in supply but better than in recent months

Supply is good

Corn

Yellow Corn – Now carrying local corn White Corn- in good supply Corn has now shown up at the Farmers Market



Limes – Sizing and quality is down, limes are under an extreme flag Lemon – Supply is steady and quality is good **Oranges** – Navels have slowed down, season will end sooner than expected, Valencias available

> Eggs Product is at normal supply

Eggplant

Supply is currently steady Farmers market eggplant is available for preorders

Grapes

Volumes are good as we are now in full grape season. Farmers market grapes in many new varieties are now available for preorder.

Lettuce

Romaines- Supply is trending lower than usual, with fair quality

Green and Red Leaf - Supplies are being affected by recent heat Iceberg lettuce - Supplies are down Butter lettuce – Good volume

> **Mushrooms** Mushroom have stabilized



Melons Cantaloupe - Production is steady Honeydew - Production is steady. Weiser Farms Mixed Melons (20#cs) – Available in house

Pineapple

Supply is tight with sizing leaning on the large side, but quality is good

Potatoes

Idaho - supplies are tight on larger size and prices are higher than normal due to the delayed planting earlier this year caused by the weather. Yukon bakers - Availability is limited and pricing remaining higher than normal Russet - Quality is getting better while pricing is coming down - two months Kennebec - Very short right now and the quality is fair at best.

Squash

Crops in good supply and quality is good with local summer squashes available at the market

Stone Fruit

Local farmers market product is in house **Peaches** – Good Supply **Cherries** – Available **Apricots, Nectarines, Plums -** Available

Tomatoes

Round- supply and quality are good Romas- Prices are down, with new crop beginning Grapes- supply has tightened up Cherry- supply is good, quality is fair Heirloom- supply is good, quality is good, local crops are all over the farmers market


