Artichokes

Demand exceeds supply. Will likely last several more weeks. Weather will also affect quality. Will continue through the end of January

Asparagus

Supplies are tight due to freezing cold weather.

Avocado

Large fruit is tighter in the market. Lots of #2 fruit

Bananas

Steady supply with good quality

Broccoli, Cauliflower, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, and Green Onions

Broccoli – Supplies are improving

Cauliflower-Supplies are improving

Broccoli – Supplies are light this week

Brussels Sprouts- supply has improved

Green Onions – Market is tight from lack of labor over holidays for harvest

Strawberries – supply is steady

Raspberry – supply is steady

Blackberries – Supply is steady

Blueberries – Supply is improving

Jumbo carrots are in tight supply. Weather has had an effect on crops nationwide.



Celery

Supply is going to remain tight until end of December awaiting field transition to Yuma from Oxnard

Corn

Yellow Corn – in poor supply and quality is poor

White Corn- in poor supply and quality is poor

Citrus

Limes – Supply has improved, but will remain a bit tight with holidays

Lemon – Supply is steady and quality is good

Oranges – Local Valencias available, Cara Cara, Blood Orange

Grapefruit – Pummelos and Melogolds available

Eggs

Product is at normal supply

Eggplant

Quality is fair

Garlic

Domestic garlic is in short supply due to numerous plants that did not develop. Chinese garlic is low due to high tariffs being applied.

Grapes

Volumes is steady. All imported product now

Lettuce

Baby Arugula, Spinaches, Kales- All in very short supply due to freezing temperatures and previous weather events. Consider Substitutions!

Romaines- Supply is trending lower than usual, weather is not helping

Green and Red Leaf – Supplies are being affected by recent rain and cold

Iceberg lettuce - Supplies are down and quality is ok, but coming rains may change that

Butter lettuce – Good volume



Melons

Cantaloupe - Production is way down with smaller fruit and less sugar

Honeydew – same as cantaloupe and demand exceeds supply

Pineapple

Good availability and quality

Potatoes

Idaho - supplies are tight on larger size and prices are higher than normal due to the delayed planting earlier this year caused by the weather.

Yukon bakers - Availability is limited and pricing remaining higher than normal

Russet - Quality is getting better while pricing is coming down - two months

Kennebec - Very short right now and the quality is fair at best.
